1. SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING 10/12/2009:

1.1 CHANGING OF POST TITLE STATION COMMISSIONER:

Our position was to demand from the employer an explanation why the post title is changed from Station Commissioner to Station Commander. Whether the employer is embarking on militarizing the SAPS. To withdraw its letter announcing the change. To start with the consultation process.

The employer responded that in terms of the employment regulations chapter 4 the National Commissioner has a duty to every 5 years review the job titles and redefine them. The employer denied being busy to militarize the SAPS. The employer is busy redefining the ranking structure and will brief council early 2010. The employer will not withdraw the letter but will seek a new mandate before 17/12/2009 or otherwise report to council on 19/01/2010.

1.2 10111 GAUTENG

The point was added to the agenda as an urgent point. The employer's response is that the unit is a provincial unit under the auspice of the Provincial Commissioner. Further that the matter is currently discussed at the provincial SSSBC and is in an advanced stage. Professional / Provincial SSSBC will be summonsed to report to council on 19/12/2010
